Uniform Policy



- Uniform Package Includes
 - Two sets of training gear
 - Two sets of uniforms
- Goalkeeper Uniform is not included with the regular Uniform Package and is required to be purchase for player specific positioning
- Uniform package is required and the cost is not included with club fees
- Travel training track suit is required for purchase not included in the uniform package, if you player already owns the 23/24 travel suit, you do not need to purcahse another
- Uniform package purchase details will be sent out to families via email
- Other required gear not included with uniform package, appropriate soccer boots and shin guards, blue and yellow penny shirt, appropriate size soccer ball, small stretch band, large stretch band and foam roller

Player Expectations



- 1. Players are required to attend all practices unless previously communicated with Director of Coaching
- 2. During school season players are required to attend at least one practice per week
- 3. Players who miss practice the day before a game will not be starting the first game of the next day
- 4. Players are required to show up 15 minutes early before practice for injury prevention exercises
- 5. Players are required to show up 45 minutes before games
- 6. Late Arrival on game day results in not starting a game
- 7. Player Backpacks and personal items at practice should not be placed on any nearby fences and personal items at games should be kept neatly behind team bench.
- 8. All players need to remember they are a representation of Alpha Soccer Academy and any indiscipline will have consequences determined by the coach and DOC.
- 9. Players on the bench during games must wear a penny and cannot interact with parents or fans while on bench
- 10. Only carded Alpha players and staff are allowed on the bench at games.
- 11. Damage to a facility or equipment by a player will be left to the responsibility of the player and family.
- 12. Any disrespect show by a player in practice or game to coach or another player will be handled accordingly and may result in a temporary suspension.
- 13. Any disrespect show by a player to another coach, team, referee or outside party will not be tolerated and may result in a temporary suspension or expulsion without refund. Situations will be dealt with on a case by case basis.









Alpha Soccer Academy Player Conduct Contract

I. Attend all scheduled practices, games, tournaments (including pre and post season tournament and events) and community service projects. In the event of an absence I will contact my coach, team manager and/or club directors and registrar to be made aware of conflicting situation and will agree to team policies in such an event.

II. Respect myself, my community, my family, my teammates, my coach, referees,

III. Demonstrate appropriate and productive behavior during all team events, including but not limited to, practices, games, tournaments, socials, community service projects, etc.

IV. Abide by the US Club and Carolina Champion League policies set forth on their own websites.

V. Comply with all tournament rules posted on tournament websites, including state cup series and any place of play within the 2021-2022 ASA season.

I understand that I am responsible for my behavior and actions. That poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with the above conditions may result in a family fine, my suspension or removal from the team and/or Alpha Soccer Academy.



III. Abide by the Spectator and Player Conduct Attachment

By reading this contract, I understand that I am responsible for the behavior and actions of myself and all other members of our family and guests. Poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. I understand the sanctions that will be implements in the case of violation of this contract and that failure to comply with the above conditions as outlines may result in the suspension or removal of the family from Alpha Soccer Academy.

Parent Expectations



- We ask that parents keep a distance from the bench during games and keep all comments to positivity and encouragement.
- Leave the coaching to the coaches, if specific coaching type comments are being told to players you will be asked to stop. If this continues and/or disrespect is show specific parents may be asked to leave.
- It is a good reminder that players are here to learn, have fun and improve and refine their skills. Let the coaches do their job. This applies to training sessions as well.
- Parents are responsible for picking up and dropping off their players.
- ASA is not responsible for keeping track of car pooling between parents and players on teams and same scheduled training sessions.
- Coaches will stay until the last player is picked up.

Spectator and Player Conduct

VOLUNTEER, SPECTATOR AND PLAYER CONDUCT ALL VOLUNTEERS and SPECTATORS are to conduct themselves in a polite and courteous manner appropriate for youth

ACCEPTABLE and UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

Acceptable Behavior

Players and spectators must abide by the Conduct Contract.

Unacceptable Behavior

All players, spectators and volunteers have the right to participate in a safe and positive environment. It is a violation of ASA guidelines to engage in or encourage others to engage in the following behavior:

- Improper verbal conduct such as insults, slurs or unwanted comment
- Improper visual conduct such as derogatory posters or gestures
- Improper physical conduct such as blocking normal movement or interference with the normal activity.
- Improper behavior that interrupts game play and a positive environment with our community.

Fees include:

- Professional Coaching.

A team may choose to attend extra tournaments at the team's expense

Community Service Liability Waiver

Our Vision: With our first-class training, we create an environment that allows our players to realize their potential on and off the soccer field, to be agents of positive change, using their gifts and talents to grow into productive women and men of society. As a club Alpha Soccer Academy stands for making a difference in our local communities. We have been given the opportunity to play soccer and we want to use our privileges to help others. We have made a commitment to your family to develop your player on and off the field and part of that is your family making a commitment to Alpha Soccer Academy. This commitment includes two service days, one per Fall and one per Spring, within the 2022-2023 season that will include a reasonable community service project for your player in conjunction with the team and club.

I agree to assume all the risks and responsibilities surrounding my participation in the community service project(s) and to release, waive, forever discharge and covenant not to sue Alpha soccer Academy it's governing board officers, agents, employees and volunteers, and affiliates, (jointly "The Parties"), from and against any and all liability for harm, injury, damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs, and/or expenses of any nature that I may have or that may hereafter accrue to me, arising out of or related to any loss damage or injury, including but not limited to suffering and death, that may be sustain by me, whether caused by the negligence of carelessness of the Parties or otherwise, while participating in the community service project(s) or while in, on, upon, or in transit to or from the premises where the

community service project(s) or while in, on, upon, or in transit to or from the premises where the community service project(s), will be performed or any adjunct to the community service project(s) occurs or is being conducted. I understand and agree that the Parties do not have medical personnel available at the location of the community service project(s). I understand and agree that the Parties are granted permission to authorize emergency medical treatment if necessary, in the such action by the Parties shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement. I understand and agree that said parties assume no responsibility for any injury or damage which might arise out of or in connection with such authorized emergency medical treatment. I

further state that I possess no health related conditions or problems while preclude or restrict my participation in this community service project(s), with or without reasonable accommodation and that I have adequate health insurance necessary to provide for and pay any medical costs that may be attendant as a result of injury to me. I sign this document knowingly and voluntarily and with no oral representation, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing a written statement, being made. I further agree that this Release shall be construed in accordance with the law of the states in which the community service project(s) are being performed. If any term or provisions of this release shall be held in illegal, unenforceable or in conflict with any law governing this Release the validity of the remaining portion shall not be affected

thereby. I declare that the information provided by me is correct and made in good faith and any information provided here is confidential unless otherwise expressed. Service projects will be chosen by the club and performed as a team, if such service project day is not foreseeable as a family, a make-up day will be provided to the player. Service projects will be performed to the best of the club's ability within the time of a normal practice, unless such project is voted on by the team performing it. Teams are not limited to two service projects, if more is desired the club will do their best to provide additional opportunities for teams and players to perform them.
